IONE Loan Forgiveness is designed to promote nursing education, including nursing staff and nurse leadership, to enable nurses to obtain advance degrees and to expand the skilled nursing workforce across Kaiser Permanente Southern California Kaiser Foundation Hospitals and Health Plan.

The Institute has available loan forgiveness funds to support completion of the following academic degree programs: RN to BSN, BSN, ABSN, MSN, DNP, and PhD.

Program Requirements

Loan Forgiveness Funds will be awarded to students who meet and continue to meet the following requirements of the IONE Program:

- Must be a full-time Kaiser Foundation Hospital (KFH)/ Health Plan employee while enrolled at the School.
- ◆ Accepted into a participating School of Nursing (APU, MSMU, CSUSM, CBU).
- Maintain continuous enrollment with progress towards graduation
- Maintenance of a cumulative 3.0 GPA (on a 4.0 scale) in all School courses taken for every grading period.
- Be a U.S citizen or national of the U.S., or lawful permanent resident of the U.S. and its territories
- Must remain employed full-time with Kaiser Permanente Southern California for 24 months from the date of graduation from the School.
- Exceptions to full loan forgiveness:
 - GPA falls below 3.0 and student does not maintain good academic standing per University catalog.
 - * Delay in graduation by more than two semesters beyond the standard program duration.
 - * Failure to progress in the program in a timely manner.
 - * Less than 24 months as Kaiser Permanente Southern California employee for reasons other than job unavailability.

Discounted Tuition

For those individuals awarded forgivable loan funds, program tuition discounts range from 10%-30%.

Tuition discounts vary based on University and Program.

Check with your selected University, as some schools may prorate the calculated percentage discount.

Tuition Rates

- Per-unit tuition rates can fluctuate based on the academic year and chosen University .
- Consult your desired University to determine tuition rates and projected rates for subsequent academic years.
- Student is responsible for paying all fees associated with course, program, and university enrollment.
- ♦ Fees may be subject to annual increases.
